Recommendations:

GIRLS

Slacks (i.e. Dockers, Khakis)
Dress or skirt
"Dressy" shorts that are at least finger tip length
Blouse or plain T-shirt
Clean athletic shoes or comfortable low heeled shoes
"Shiloh" sweatshirt or T-shirts
Light jacket
Rain protection (raincoat, poncho, or umbrella)

NOTE--Clothing MAY NOT have any message other than one pertaining to Shiloh Middle School or Parma High School.

BOYS

Dress or sport shirts
Plain T-shirt
Slacks (i.e. Dockers, Khakis, or other types of "no-iron" slacks)
"Dressy" shorts that are at least finger tip length
Clean athletic shoes
"Shiloh" sweatshirt or T-shirts
Light jacket
Rain protection (raincoat, poncho, or umbrella)

NOTE--Clothing MAY NOT have any message other than one pertaining to Shiloh Middle School or Parma High School.

Unacceptable Attire

Blue jeans, high heels, flip-flops, sweatpants, spandex garments, provocative clothing, very casual clothing, garments with rips or holes, clothing with a message other than one pertaining to Shiloh Middle School or Parma High School
